A covenant is an agreement made by two or more persons. In the church, it represents more: it is a solemn agreement or vow. 5. I commit to musical excellence demonstrated by a willingness to practice and mature as a musician. I will commit to avoid jealousy or any type of competition. (1 Cor. 12:5-7)
6. I will strive to maintain a pure personal life (1 Pet. 1:15-16) and have a willingness to disclose to the leadership of the church any struggles or failures I may be having.
7. I will exhibit genuine love for the people to whom I minister. I will not seek to use my position to benefit personally at their expense. (1 John 4:20)
8. I will be a committed, regular member of Spring Valley, support the church leaders, and tithe cheerfully to the church. (2 Cor. 9:6-8)
